

2011 Bluegrass In Paradise Volunteer FAQ

How do I sign up?

What are the requirements of volunteers?

- All volunteers must sign a waiver, and be 18 years of age.
- Must attend orientation on Friday July 8, 2011.
- Each Volunteer must complete 8 hours of work in exchange for a Festival pass. Most shifts will be four hours long.
- We try our best to our volunteers around their choices (friends, bands etc), but it may not always be possible or logical.
- Volunteers are required to put down a deposit for total \$90 (one weekend Festival pass). **This deposit is completely refundable for volunteers that complete their work obligations to Bluegrass In Paradise.**
- Volunteers **agree to be on time to all assigned shifts** and complete the responsibilities of each shift in a satisfactory manner. Each volunteer will receive a schedule with their schedule and check in location. Arriving 10 minutes early is being on time.
- Volunteers are welcome to do whatever they choose during their free time as long as you are on time and ready to work for your shift.
- Volunteers must work in closed-toed shoes. You will not be able to work if you do not arrive in closed-toed shoes.
- Volunteers must advise the Volunteer coordinator once their shifts have been completed to alleviate any issues following the Festival.
- Bluegrass In Paradise Volunteer T-shirts must be worn during shift, and taken off when not on shift.
- Absolutely no drugs or alcohol may be consumed during a Bluegrass In Paradise Shift. Deposits will be forfeited.

What type of jobs/departments could I be working in?

Essentially volunteers are on hand to help out when and where they are needed. Based upon changing needs you may start one team, and move to another. We appreciate your flexibility and ability to lend a hand where needed. Teams include box office, floaters, security, merchandise, and hospitality.
